Each team may have up to 15 players. All team members must have the same color uniforms with numbers.

#### Admission Fees per day

Adults (18 and older) \$4.00

Students (12 - 17 years of age) \$1.00

Children under the age of 12 - FREE

Concessions & Raffles will be available throughout the tournament.

***This Double-elimination tournament will be a three-day tournament (8 teams), with a three game minimum (additional Consolation games). All High School regulation rules will apply with the following exception:***

1. All teams may consist of Boys in the 3rd and/or 4<sup>th</sup> grade – please specify grade level for your players.
2. All games will consist of 4, six-minute quarters, stopped time.
3. Basket height will be 9 feet.
4. Foul line will be used, jumping over the line will be allowed while following through on the shot, not advancing for their own rebound.
5. A 28.5 ball will be used for all games.
6. 3-point line will be used.
7. Half-time interval will be five minutes. There will be a two-minute break in between other periods.
8. In the event of a tie, a three-minute overtime will be played.
9. Each team will be allowed two time-outs (1 min each) per game. Un-used time outs will not carry into the overtime period. One time-out for each overtime period will be given.
10. Defense: No zone defense, all man to man with help defense allowed within the key / bucket. This will be monitored by referees as close as possible with their discretion.
11. Press: A team may press in the last two minutes of each half unless it has a lead of 10 or more points. Strictly man to man with NO trapping and NO Double team!
